Details of award	<p>The ASCEPT Lectureship is awarded biennially to a member of ASCEPT who has made a significant and sustained contribution to the development of pharmacology and/or toxicology in Australasia.</p> <p>ASCEPT Lectureship is awarded every second year on even numbered years</p>								
Eligibility criteria	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Financial member of ASCEPT. • Nominees for the Award must have been ASCEPT members for at least the previous 2 years, or if a valid interruption to membership exists, have been a member of ASCEPT for at least 2 years prior to the suspension of membership. • Nominees for this medal are required to be nominated and seconded by two current ASCEPT members, with at least one from outside the nominee's institution. The Nominator must submit the application. • Have not received this award, or the ASCEPT Michael Rand Medal, in the previous 7 years. 								
Application	<p>Applications must be submitted to the ASCEPT Executive Officer via email at ascept@ascept.org by the deadline.</p> <p>The application should include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A statement from the nominator/s providing details of the relevant contributions the nominee has made to the development of pharmacology and/or toxicology in Australasia. • The nominee's CV. • A statement of relative to opportunity, if relevant. 								
Selection process	<p>Applications will be assessed by an ASCEPT Board-appointed judging panel chaired by the President or a delegated member of the ASCEPT Executive. The judging panel will be assembled in accordance with the ASCEPT Equity, Diversity and Inclusion Policy and any real or perceived conflicts of interests will be declared and recorded.
